IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Journey to Shillong, the Capital City of Meghalaya

Air

The Airport at Umroi, is about 35 km from Shillong. Boeing Air Alliances Flights (50 seaters) operate on this route to Kolkata and Jorhat on Tues, Thurs, Sun. There is a restriction on checkin baggage of 15 kg only. A convenient International airport, the Gopinath Bordoloi Airport is in Guwahati (128 km from Shillong) which is connected to rest of India with regular flights.

Helicopter Service

Helicopter is available from Guwahati to Shillong and Shillong to Guwahati daily except on Sunday. It takes 20 mins. to reach Shillong from Guwahati

Rail

There are no rail lines in Meghalaya. The nearest railway station is Guwahati. It is 104 km from Shillong and very well connected with all major cities of India.

Road

National Highway 40, an all-weather road, connects Shillong with Guwahati.

Prepaid mobiles on roaming from other than Northeastern States will not work in Shillong
